Giorgio Di Giorgio (Milan 1943) graduated in 1969 in the Faculty of Architecture of the Sapienza University of Rome, with a degree in urban design, supervisor Ludovico Quaroni.

He began working as researcher and teacher in the same faculty in 1970.

He was in charge first of Architectural design courses and later of Interior Architecture courses.

Since 2007, He is full professor of Interior Architecture in the Faculty of Architecture of the Sapienza University.

Today He is:

- Member of the Academic Committee of the PhD course in "Architecture - Theory and Project" of the Sapienza University;
- member of the Scientific Committee of the postgraduate course in "Architecture for Archaeology - Archaeology for Architecture" of the Sapienza University.

He has held numerous academic and scientific appointments, including that of Vice Dean of the Faculty of Architecture "L. Quaroni ", coordinator of the doctorate in "Architecture - Theory and Project" and director of the postgraduate course in "Architecture for Archaeology - Archaeology for Architecture" of the Sapienza University.

He has organized and participated in international conferences and has promoted numerous international workshops whose aim was the rehabilitation of urban fabric.
